GREAT GRANSDEN BELLS.

Thank you for running through the project with me again on site on 28th November.

The variations to the scheme, such as the omission of a new ringing floor, do not, in my opinion, affect the overall principles which have been accepted by the Diocesan Advisory Committee, and I can see no difficulty in securing a faculty for the work.

The project strikes a sound balance between practical considerations and conservation, and the important dated frame will remain with one of the bells for which it was made. This is the only scheme of its kind where frame **and** bell will remain together.

I consider this project to be very important given the paucity of ringing towers in this part of the Diocese. The church, in effect, serves two villages so far as ringing is concerned and I am greatly impressed with the commitment to and careful management of the project which you have before the Millennium fund.

On all measures this is a very good scheme, and I hope that the Millennium fund will support it.
